- Ability to communicate in English.


The Offer - Working Conditions

The best evaluated application will be selected to apply for a PFIS contract with the IRBLIeida.

If funded by the ISCIII, the contract will be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the call.

The selected person, in case of receiving the grant, will join the research group "Cancer Biomarkers Research Group [GReBiC]" and will develop the doctoral thesis in the framework of the project "Biomarkers of Response to Immunotherapy by Exhaustive Immunophenotyping of Gastric Adenocarcinoma". The specific tasks to be carried out are related to the bioinformatic analysis of multi-omics data, as well as the preclinical validation of the results in in vitro/vivo models of cancer.
