The Institute

The Biomedical Research Institute of Lleida Fundació Dr. Pifarré (IRBLleida) was established with the aim of creating synergies between basic, clinical and epidemiological research, making biomedical research a key driver to improve current clinical practice. IRBLleida covers a chain of translational research, from basic research, aimed at understanding the physiological and pathological mechanisms of the human body, to research that studies the behavior of diseases in large population groups.

The Biomedical Research Institute of Lleida ([IRBLleida](#)) was founded in 2004 through a cooperation agreement between the University of Lleida (UdL) and the Catalan Healthcare system. IRBLleida integrates research groups of the faculties of Medicine and Nursing and Physiotherapy of the UdL. On the other hand, we incorporate research groups from:

1. The Catalan Health Institute ([ICS](#)) both at the hospital level (Arnau de Vilanova University Hospital - [HUAV](#)) and the primary healthcare of [Lleida](#) and the [Alt Pirineu-Aran Health Region](#),
2. The healthcare provider [Gestió de Serveis Sanitaris \(GSS; Santa María University Hospital - HUSM, Pallars Regional Hospital](#) and [Mental Health](#), among others).

IRBLleida has been a CERCA institute since 2013, and as such is organized according to a model of good governance and operation that ensures efficiency, management flexibility, talent recruitment and promotion, strategic planning and executive capacity. It is also one of the 34 Spanish Health Research Institute ([IIS](#)) recognized by the [Carlos III Health Institute](#) and the Government of the Generalitat, as established by Law 16/2003, of 28 May, on the cohesion and quality of the national health system.

Context and tasks to be developed:

A laboratory technician position is offered in the group of Precision Medicine in Chronic Diseases, led by Dr. Manuel Sánchez de la Torre, from the Institute of Biomedical Research of Lleida (IRBLleida).

The work will be carried out in the context of the project PMP22/00030 "Impact of Sleep-disordered Breathing Management in Systemic Hypertension Control: METASLEEP project", HYPERSLEEP", included in the research line of Precision Medicine in Chronic Diseases, under the direction and supervision of Dr. Manuel Sánchez de la Torre, Ramon y Cajal researcher at the University of Lleida, and Dr. Ferran Barbé, Clinical Director of Respiratory Medicine of Lleida and Director of CIBERES.

The selected person will join a multidisciplinary research group with high research activity, scientific production and a strong basic-clinical translational component.

The activities he/she will carry out will consist of setting up and coordinating the new multicentre project, in which 10 centres in Spain collaborate, awarded in the call for research projects in personalised medicine 2022. The main objective of this project is to establish a new paradigm in the treatment of hypertension through the management of nocturnal respiratory problems.

This contract is funded by the Instituto de Salud Carlos III, file PMP22/00030. This action is co-funded by the European Union - NextGenerationEU and by the Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan.

Valued:

- Current Certificate of Good Clinical Practice 5 points
- Knowledge of written and spoken English (Level B1 or higher) 5 points
- Submission of papers to conferences 15 points
- Publication of articles in indexed scientific journals 15 points

b) Certified professional experience - 40 points

Valued:

- Demonstrable experience in applied clinical research 10 points
- Demonstrable experience in database and os management and RedCap handling. 10 points
- Knowledge and skills in patient management software: Fundanet and/or SAP 10 points
- Knowledge and mastery of the statistical software R 10 points

c) Competence test or interview - 20 points
